Notice of Sierra Madre Villa Avenue and East Barhite Street Project

Dear Customers,

The Sierra Madre Villa Avenue and East Barhite Street Project is an integral part of the *Water System Master Plan* that was developed after the Kinneloa wildfire in 1993 to improve the ability of the Kinneloa Irrigation District (KID) to provide greater capacity to fight wildfires or structure fires. This project will replace the current pipeline with a new larger pipeline in Sierra Madre Villa Avenue between Vosburg Street and Barhite Street and then east on Barhite Street and will provide an improved emergency preparedness capability in the immediate neighborhood as well to homes south of Vosburg Street.

The KID awarded a contract to J.A. Salazar Construction & Supply Corporation for construction of the pipeline. The duration of the entire project will be approximately 80 calendar days starting on May 8, 2017, but the construction of the section impacting the streets will be only a portion of that period. Between 7:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, there may be work vehicles and equipment travelling on the streets during the construction and periods when it is necessary to restrict traffic to one lane or to stop traffic for a short time period. There will also be temporary storage of equipment and materials to facilitate the project. The project area is shown below.
